A Providential Time



Lent comes to us as a providential time to change course, to recover the ability to react to the reality of evil which always challenges us. Lent is to be lived as a time of conversion, as a time of renewal for individuals and communities, by drawing close to God and by trustfully adhering to the Gospel.

In this way, it also allows us to look with new eyes at our brothers and sisters and their needs. That is why Lent is a favorable time to convert to the love of God and neighbor; a love that knows how to make its own the Lord's attitude of gratuitousness and mercy— who "became poor, so that by his poverty you might become rich" (cf 2 Cor 8:9).

Reflection: In what ways can you look "with new eyes" at your brothers and sisters and their needs. Pray that God will allow you to look upon others with more mercy.

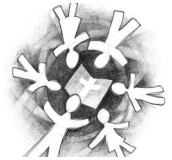
