**To Overcome Egotism
Pray the Rosary**

FEAST OF OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY

Here I would like to emphasize the beauty of a simple contemplative prayer, accessible to all, great and small, the educated and those with little education. It is the prayer of the Holy Rosary. In the Rosary, we turn to the Virgin Mary so that she may guide us to an ever closer union with her Son, Jesus, to bring us into conformity with him, to have his sentiments and to behave like him.



Indeed, in the Rosary, while we repeat the Hail Mary we meditate on the mysteries, on the events in Christ's life, so as to know and love him ever better. The Rosary is an effective means for opening ourselves to God, for it helps us to overcome egotism and to bring peace to hearts, in the family, in society, and in the world.

Reflection: Pray the Rosary today, focusing on the mysteries and imagining each scene and what it must have been like to be there. Pray for the wisdom to understand how these scenes relate to your own life.


