A Roped Guide



The Ascension of Jesus into heaven acquaints us with this deeply consoling reality on our journey: In Christ, true God and true man, our humanity was taken to God. Christ opened the path to us. He is like a roped guide climbing a mountain who, on reaching the summit, pulls us up to him and leads us to God. DISPENSATION LIFTED EFFECTIVE MAY 22/23, 2021

In a letter sent to parishioners, Bishop John informed us that the dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days will be lifted effective the weekend of Pentecost, May 22 and 23rd. The CDC has lifted the face mask restrictions and social distancing for those who are vaccinated, but Father Frank asks that, for the good of those who have not been vaccinated, that all continue to wear masks and practice social distancing. We will continue to come forward for the Eucharist in single file and receive on the hand. The Bishop also asks anyone exposed to COVID or not feeling well to please not attend.

If you feel that you need an extension of the dispensation during the pandemic, individual dispensations can be granted one month at a time by Father Frank. This dispensation will need to be renewed monthly. Please call Father Frank at 643-7671 to receive an individual dispensation.

21 x 14 - \$300

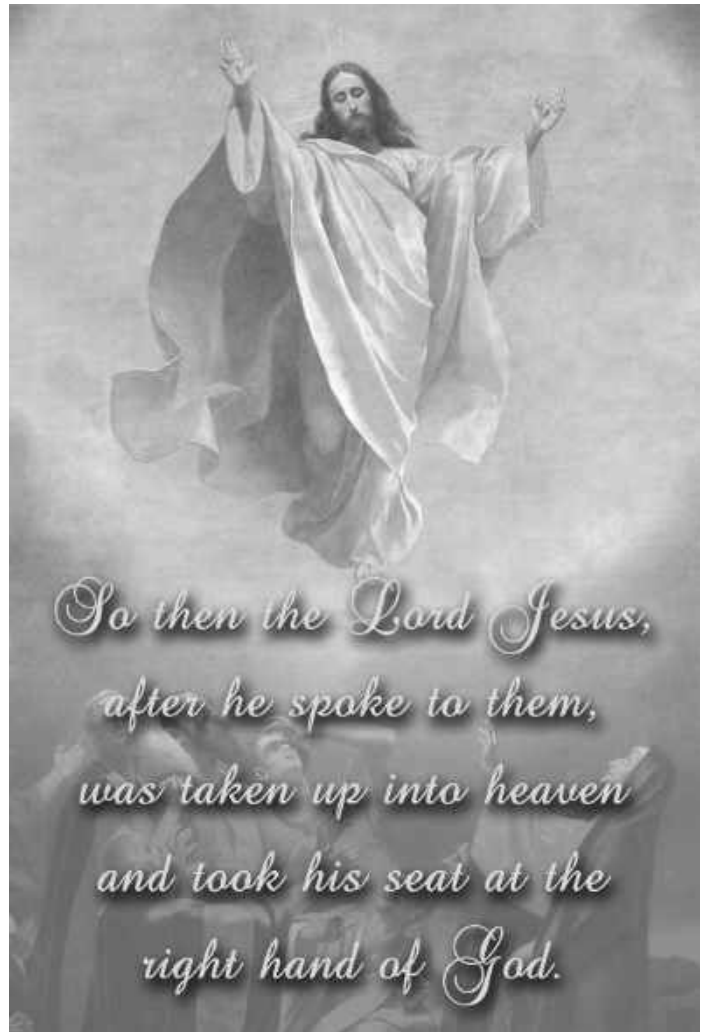
14 x 14 - \$250
