Are You on the Right Path?

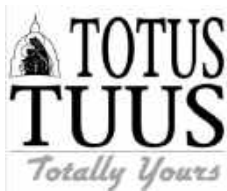

Hypocrites cannot do this, for they are so full of themselves that they are blind to seeing others. [But] when one journeys a little and draws near to the Lord, the light of the Father enables one to see these things and to go out to help one’s brothers and sisters.
