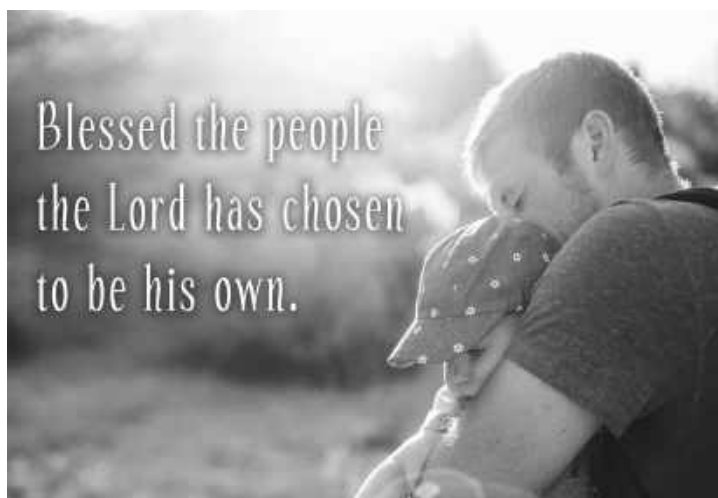

August 7: In a little over two months at LaPointe, Fr. Baraga has baptized 160 Natives, a glorious harvest of souls.

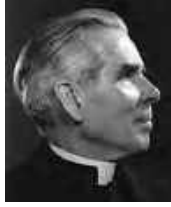

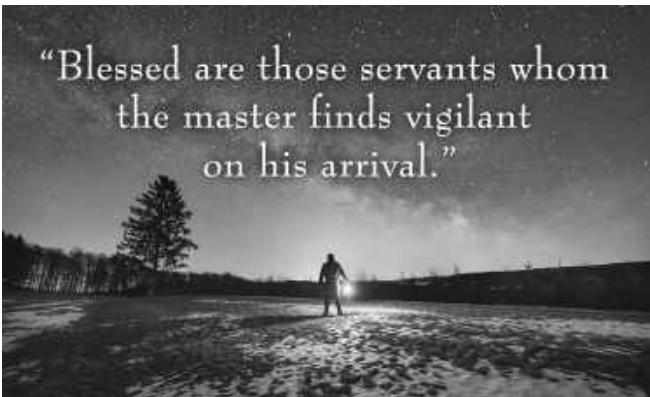

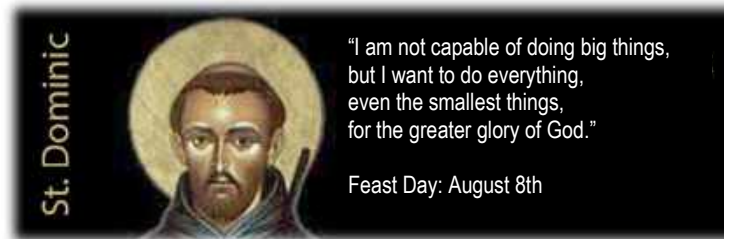
PRAYER FOR PEACE

THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

Because the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary falls on a Monday this year, it is not a holy day of obligation.

Whenever January 1, the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God; or August 15, the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin; or November 1, the Solemnity of All Saints, falls on a Saturday or on a Monday, the obligation to attend Mass is lifted. The faithful, however, are encouraged to attend Mass on those days.
