**Reflections with Pope Francis**  
**We Are Completely in God's Hands**

Jesus predicts that his disciples will have to suffer painful trials and persecution for his sake. He reassures them, however, saying, "Not a hair on your head will perish" (Lk 21:18). This reminds us that we are completely in God's hands! The trials we encounter for our faith and our commitment to the Gospel are occasions to give witness; we must not distance ourselves from the Lord, but instead abandon ourselves even more to him, to the power of his Spirit and his grace.

*Reflection: What trials and persecutions are you facing right now? Ask the Lord to draw near to you in your suffering. Ask him to help you remember his suffering and his mercy in these times.*
