## Reflections with Pope Francis

### Sin Makes the Headlines



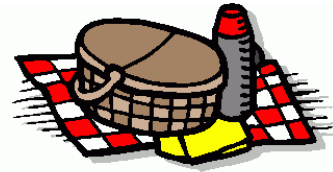
In the media, holiness is not news; outrage and sin make the headlines. How can this be a fair fight? Who can fight against this? Do some of us possibly dream we can fight with merely human means...? Be careful.... Our struggle is not against human powers but against the powers of darkness (see Ephesians 6:12). Just as it happened to Jesus (see Matthew 4:1-11), Satan is seeking to seduce us, to disorient us, to offer us "viable alternatives".... We need to find refuge in the power of the Word of God like Jesus did in the desert.

We need to resort to begging in prayer: ...the prayer of the humble and poor without any resources. The humble have nothing to lose. In fact, God reveals the way to them (see Matthew 11:25-26).... We cannot simply relax in our complacency.... This is a time for prayer.

***Reflection:** Do you really believe that Satan is seeking to seduce and disorient you? If this is the case, how are you fighting this battle? Pray for the strength to resist temptation, and spread God's love to others.*

and amazing summertime blessings. Amen.

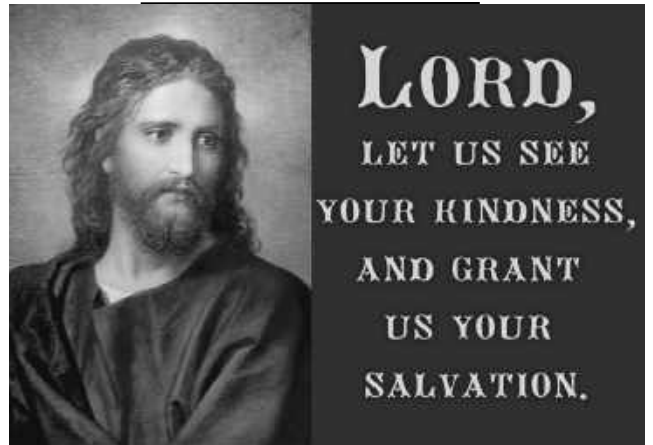


## Church Picnic
